CESER leads the Emergency Support Function #12 responders, a team of highly skilled and trained energy specialists, to support energy restoration efforts from natural or human-caused incidents including hurricanes, winter storms, fires or terrorist attacks. HAMMER helps coordinate response, provides logistical support and, when needed deploys members of its own team to catastrophic incidents to help restore life-giving energy resources throughout the nation.
