The HAMMER Campus

HAMMER's 88-acre campus includes classrooms, specialized training areas and life-size props for industrial, workplace and emergency scenarios. These facilities embody HAMMER's motto, "Training as Real as it Gets," allowing students to train safely in realistic environments. The campus also supports mock-ups, technology testing, accident staging and military exercises.



Since 2002, HAMMER has been a DOE Voluntary Protection Program Star site, exemplifying high workplace safety standards.

Hands-on Training

HAMMER combines subject matter experts, contractors and worker trainers to deliver high-quality training, fostering a strong safety culture at Hanford. Worker trainers embody meaningful worker involvement and the strong partnership between management and the workforce. As a recognized safety advocate, worker trainers bridge the gap between field and classroom, integrating real-world insights.



The Construction Worker Safety Training Program efficiently trains Hanford construction workers, recognizing building trades' programs and granting equivalencies to Hanford and Pacific Northwest National Laboratory training. This reduces redundancies, saves costs and enhances worker portability.

National Programs

HAMMER extends its expertise to federal, state, military and community partners for national emergency preparedness and response. It supports DOE's Office of Cybersecurity, Energy Security, and Emergency Response, aiding to secure and restore energy after disasters strike. HAMMER trains and manages the deployment of DOE's energy restoration team and supports the Department of Transportation's hazardous material response, PNNL's International Border Security Training and other regional and federal programs.
