



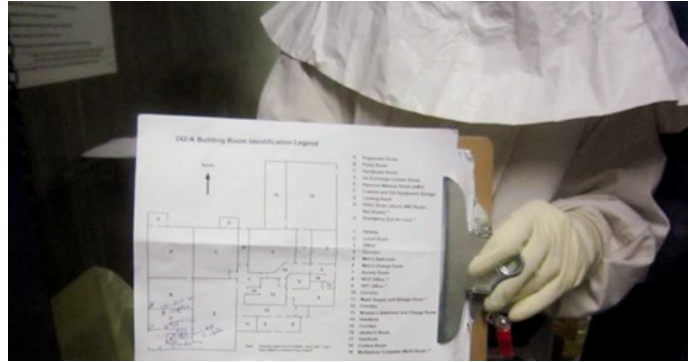
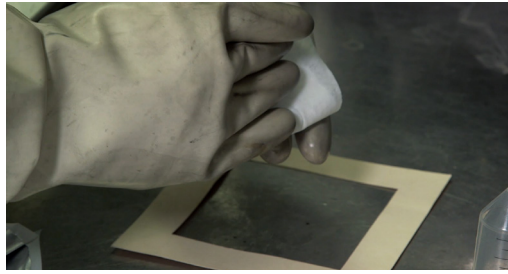
# BERYLLIUM TRAINING

Hanford workers face beryllium legacy hazards from the Manhattan Project and Cold War era. Exposure to beryllium is hazardous to the Hanford workforce. Workers gain vital knowledge on sitewide requirements and controls for high-hazard beryllium work in HAMMER's Beryllium Training Program.

- Produces knowledgeable workers prepared for beryllium work
- Educates workers on beryllium hazards and exposure risks
- Subject matter experts and worker trainers provide critical real-world knowledge of hazards
- Encourages a culture of safety

Specialized training equips workers with knowledge and skills to work competently and safely in the field. Worker trainers and certified industrial hygienists share their expertise and experience to deliver meaningful training skills designed to protect workers and reduce exposure risks.

Students are trained to perform beryllium hazard identification and assessments, control strategies, contamination prevention, and use personal protective equipment to mitigate hazards. Blended learning ensures training sticks and workers are prepared for work in beryllium environments.
