



CONSTRUCTION WORKER SAFETY TRAINING PROGRAM

HAMMER's Construction Worker Safety Training Program (CWSTP) brings worker safety training to a higher standard. Workers are provided with consistent, high-quality, portable training which enhances safety awareness throughout the Site.

- Emphasizes worker safety
- Reduces training redundancies
- Avoids costs
- Provides standardized training and equivalencies
- Supports pre-job meetings to identify training requirements

The CWSTP is unique to the Hanford Site and addresses the specific needs of Building Trades workers. It was created as a joint venture between DOE, HAMMER, the Central Washington Building and Construction Trades Council, and contractors to ensure safety and health training is consistent throughout the Site.

The CWSTP allows construction workers to move between projects and contractors on the Hanford Site without redundant training, avoiding costs and lost worker hours. The program also grants equivalencies for training received through union affiliates and tracks training through a centralized records system.
